

Offer - Specialized internship in ophthalmology

The training

This specialized internship represents an excellent opportunity to benefit from high-quality training under the supervision of Dr. Aurélie Sauvage (ECVO diplomate) and Dr. Florine Narinx (board-eligible resident). The candidate will also work in collaboration with a second specialized intern. He/she will participate in consultations, surgeries, and the care of hospitalized animals (small animals and horses). He/she will also play a key role in student training. The ophthalmology case load is around 1000 cases for companion animals and 300 cases for horses per year, with some cases involving exotic pets.



The clinic

Our clinic is fully equipped with cutting-edge technology, providing you with all the necessary tools to diagnose and treat a wide range of ophthalmic conditions, from dogs and cats, horses to exotic animals.

The team comprises numerous European specialists: ECVS, ECVIM-CA, ECVN, ECVDI, ECVAA, ECVECC, ECAR, ECVCN, ECVD, ECVO, as well as residents and rotating interns.

- Holder of a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree (or equivalent)
- Completion of a rotating internship in small animals or equine (or equivalent)
- Excellent organizational skills, autonomy, communication skills
- Pedagogical skills towards students
- Familiarity with both horses and small animals
- Proficiency in French (B2) and English
