



Offer - Specialized Internship in Large Animal Diagnostic Imaging

THE TRAINING

This internship provides a unique opportunity to improve your knowledge and skills in Large Animal Diagnostic Imaging starting September 1, 2026. You will learn under the close supervision of 7 ECVDI diplomates (SA and/or LA) and 1 senior clinician. You will participate in the management of patients admitted to diagnostic imaging during the daytime schedule, in emergencies and on-call, including some small animal cases. You will be actively involved in the supervision of students. This position is suitable for candidates seeking to increase their experience in diagnostic imaging, possibly in preparation of a residency program.



THE CLINIC

The Veterinary University Clinic (CVU) at the University of Liège is a renowned institution for veterinary care, education, and research. With specialists from various disciplines, the CVU offers advanced diagnostic and therapeutic services for animals and provide a training ground for future veterinarians and specialists.



SKILLS

The candidate should be a team player, eager to grow and a critical thinker, and have a collaborative and knowledge-sharing mindset. She/he should hold a diploma in veterinary medicine recognized within the European Union or deemed equivalent with the right to be registered or to be eligible for registration with the Belgian Veterinary Order. He/she should have completed a rotating large animal internship or have an equivalent clinical experience. He/she should have a good knowledge of the French language, or a strong willingness to learn french to reach an operational level, to efficiently communicate with students and colleagues.

Your application should include a curriculum vitae, a cover letter, and 2 letters of reference. All applicants are encouraged to schedule a visit of the clinic.
