THE TRAINING COURSE

This internship provides a unique opportunity to improve your knowledge and skills in Companion Animal Surgery starting September 1, 2026. You will learn under the close supervision of 3 ECVS diplomates. The intern will participate in the management of patients admitted for consultation, as well as in surgical interventions and post-operative care (hospitalization). He/she will also take part in the on-call service. He/she will be actively involved in supervising students, particularly in hospitalization, and by providing first-line consultations and surgical interventions at the Prince Laurent Foundation.

The Veterinary University Clinic (CVU) at the University of Liège is a renowned institution for veterinary care, education, and research. With specialists from various disciplines, we offer advanced diagnostic and therapeutic services for animals and provide a training ground for future veterinarians and specialists.



SKILLS

The candidate should hold a DVM or equivalent degree from an accredited veterinary school and a rotating internship in companion animals. Proficiency in the French language is essential (B2 level). Effective communication and interpersonal skills are essential attributes, as the role requires collaboration within a team-oriented environment.
