



## Specialized Internship in Emergency and Critical Care

### Academic year 2026-2027



### THE TRAINING COURSE

The internship provides a unique opportunity to gain knowledge and skills in Companion Animal Emergency and Critical care, starting on September or October 1st, 2026. The ECC-service is a state-of-the-art facility, including but not limited to mechanical ventilation and extracorporeal therapies. You will train under the close supervision of 2 ECVECC diplomates and a senior clinician in ECC. Your team is further completed by 2 ECVECC residents, 2 ECC PhD-assistants, 4 ECC-interns and 6 ECC nurses. Interns participate in the management of patients admitted to the emergency service and those residing in the intensive care service. Interns are actively involved in supervising students and can perform a clinical research project in collaboration with the team of supervisors.



### THE CLINIC

The Veterinary University Clinic (CVU) at the University of Liège is a renowned institution for veterinary care, education, and research. With specialists from various disciplines, we offer advanced diagnostic and therapeutic services for animals and provide a training ground for future veterinarians and specialists.



### SKILLS

The candidate should hold a DVM or equivalent degree from an accredited veterinary school and a rotating internship in companion animals or 2 years of experience in private practice. Proficiency in the French language (B2 level) and a strong desire to teach are essential. Effective communication and interpersonal skills are desired attributes, as the role requires collaboration within a team-oriented environment.
