The training

This internship provides a unique opportunity to improve your knowledge and skills in oncology as a multidisciplinary discipline, starting October 1, 2026. The intern will participate in the management of patients admitted for consultation in medical oncology and radiotherapy, administration of chemotherapy, and care of hospitalized patients. Participation to consultations in internal medicine is included in the training program, as well as exposure to consultations in surgical oncology. They will also take part in the on-call service. They will be actively involved in training of students.



The clinic

Skills

Effective communication and interpersonal skills are essential attributes, as the role requires collaboration within a team-oriented environment.
