Qualifications: Qualifications include a DVM or equivalent veterinary degree, residency training in small animal emergency and critical care medicine and certification by the American College of Veterinary Emergency Critical Care (ACVECC) or the European College of Veterinary Emergency and Critical Care (ECVECC). Candidates qualified to take the ACVECC or ECVECC certification examination are encouraged to apply. Eligibility for faculty licensure in Oklahoma is required.

If you have a passion for teaching while saving lives this is the position for you. You would be joining a team that includes 1 ACVIM SAIM diplomate, 2 ACVECC diplomates, a 5 DVM primary care service, a shelter medicine & surgery service, a 4 DVM small animal ER service, and skilled RVTs and nurse assistants.
