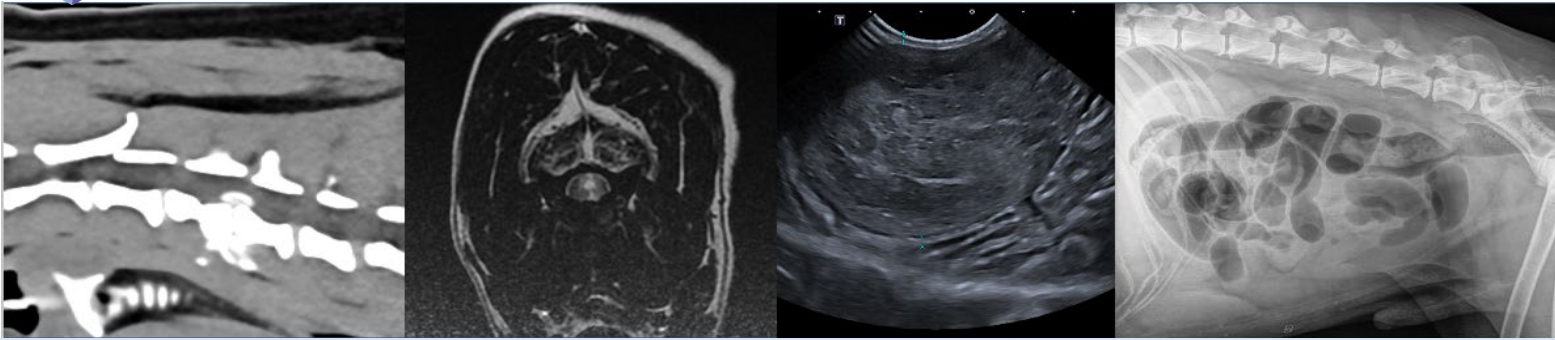




Offer - Senior Clinician in Small Animal Diagnostic Imaging



THE OFFER

The Small Animal Teaching Hospital of the University of Liège, Belgium offers position for a Senior Clinician in Small Animal Diagnostic Imaging. He/she will be part of the diagnostic imaging team which comprises 8 ECVDI diplomates (SA and/or LA), 1 senior clinician, 4 residents (3 SA and 1 LA), a diagnostic imaging intern and 4 technicians. He/she will be involved in clinical teaching to students, interns and residents. Part-time position is possible. Development of research activity is a possibility (PhD thesis, etc...).



THE CLINIC

The Small Animal Teaching Hospital is a state-of-the art facility equipped with the most advanced equipment including 1.5 Tesla MRI, 64 slices CT scan, endoscopy, minimally invasive equipment, diode laser, radiation therapy, a blood bank center, hemodialysis, mechanical ventilation, among others. Case load for companion animals is around 15000 cases a year.

The current team includes diplomates in internal medicine (5 ECVIM-CA), surgery (3 ECVS), emergency and intensive care (2 ECVECC), anaesthesiology (2 ECVA and 1 ACVAA), reproduction (1 ECAR), ophthalmology (1 ECVO), cardiology (2 ECVIM-CA cardiology), neurology (1 ECVN), sport medicine and rehabilitation (1 ECVSMR) and nutrition (1 ECVCN). REQUIREMENTS

Candidates are expected to have an ECVDI/ACVR diploma or to be Board eligible. Knowledge of spoken French is required in order to interact with students and colleagues or an intensive language course should be followed.
