#### **About the Executive Committee:**

The EBVS Executive Committee comprises the President, Senior Vice-President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer. Members are elected by the Board from among representatives of fully-recognised Colleges. The Executive Committee reviews policies and procedures, develops recommendations for Board review and approval, supports strategic planning, develops the agenda for the General Assembly, oversees day-to-day operations, and addresses matters referred to it by the Board or President between General Assemblies.

#### **Term of Office:**

Each term is 3 years, with annual re-election by the Board.

- President & Vice-Presidents: Up to 3 years
- Secretary & Treasurer: Up to 6 years (with Board approval)
- Maximum total duration on the Executive Committee: 12 years

#### **Eligibility:**

Nominees must have previously served on the EBVS Board.
